Context - Peru



- The most vulnerable areas of the country are situated in the highlands and jungle of Peru.

- 76% of extreme poverty is found in rural areas.

- Growth in higher education among the poor is 7.5%, while among the non-poor growth is 33.9%.

- 67% of women work in the informal sector and without legal or labor protection.

- In 2017, 65.4% of women aged 15 to 49 were victims of violence.

We plan...

- To welcome and provide support to young women from marginal urban areas and rural areas, especially from the mountain and jungle areas, women who lack access to the continuity of a technical or higher education in their local areas.

- To accompany young women in their integral development, in respect and value for themselves, in their ethical formation, in their leadership and in strengthening them as responsible and committed citizens.

- To promote Christian vocations, from their ultimate call to holiness, to a life of commitment to society and the Church, in their role as laity, in family life or in consecrated life.

- To accompany young candidates for religious life based in the charism of Divine Providence.

Having a low level of education is a significant risk factor for violence against women and children.
